Daily Bread Distribution

Bread and pastry donations are available in the foyer Monday through Friday during office hours.

Weekend Backpack Meal Program

This program partners with approx. 35 schools in and around Red Deer to provide food for weekend meals up to 330 children during the school year. Each week backpacks are dropped off at schools.

Grocery Assistance (Food Bank)

We provide on average 80-100 food hampers a month to individual/families in our community. People may come once every eight weeks for food bank assistance.

Clothing Assistance

Families/individuals in need of clothing assistance may come to the office and do an assessment and will receive clothing if they qualify.

Hospital to Home program

This program has two different ways it helps. It can help clients who just got out of a long stay at the hospital with food and personal care delivered to their residence. It also can be accessed by individuals that go into the hospital for long periods of stay with a little bit of clothing and personal care for their stay.

Pastoral Care

Upon request, we are available to individuals who would like to have someone to speak with or to pray with them. This is not counselling.

The Salvation Army Seniors' Luncheons

This is an opportunity for those who are 60+ to get together and enjoy a served meal and program. Each week there is either music, games or a special guest speaker. There is a cost of \$10 to attend this event.

Santa Shuffle

The Santa Shuffle is a family friendly fundraiser that is held on the first Saturday in December. Participants can register for the 1KM Elf Walk or the 5 KM Santa Shuffle. All of the funds raised stay here in Red Deer to support all of our programs.

Christmas Kettle Campaign

The Christmas Kettle Campaign runs every year from Mid-November through to Christmas. Over 2400 hours of volunteer time are given at this time. All of the funds that are raised through the Kettle Campaign stay in Red Deer to support our programs.

Innisfail Thrift Store

Innisfail Thrift Store allows us to assist families/individuals in the surrounding community through many of the same assistance programs that we run in Red Deer.

Christmas Assistance (Remand Bags)

Over 100 treat bags are given to the men and women who are/will be in the Remand Centre in Red Deer over the Christmas Season.

Christmas Hampers (Adopt-A-Family/Senior)

Each year we take applications from families/seniors that need some extra assistance over the Christmas Season. Each family/senior is matched with a sponsor family that provides gifts and food gift cards.

Some sponsors are unable to sponsor (adopt) a family but do donate toys, gift cards etc. Those donations are put together and with The Salvation

Army portion we make sure that all who apply are able to have a special day.

We have wonderful partners like ATCO Gas. ATCO Gas partners with us for one day of delivery to all of the sponsored families. We are recipients of toys from the Christmas Wish Breakfast as well as many other organizations that hold toy drives in their churches and seniors' homes.

Kids Summer Camps

Through the funds raised throughout the year we are able to send a number of children to The Salvation Army camp at Pine Lake.

Mom and Tots Camp - This camp is a week-long for Moms and their children up to age 6.
